**Subject:** Global Quality P4P – New Rosters

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Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) is pleased to announce that four additional rosters have been added to the Provider Web Portal to assist Providers with identifying Members in need of outreach for specific care. By providing the care needed and submitting the corresponding data to IEHP, you will positively impact your Global Quality P4P incentive goals. New rosters include Members identified in the following measures:

1. **Annual Monitoring for Patients on Persistent Medications (MPM)** – Roster tracks compliance of ambulatory medication therapy for select therapeutic agents in the measurement year (2017): ACE/ARB, Digoxin, and Diuretics. Screening types and dates are listed for compliant components.
2. **Immunizations for Adolescents (IMA)** – Rosters track compliance of adolescent Members 13 years of age who had one dose of meningococcal conjugate vaccine, one tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis (Tdap) vaccine, and 2 or 3 doses of the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine on or before their 13<sup>th</sup> birthday.
3. **Medication Management for People with Asthma (MMA) 75% Rate** – Roster tracks compliance of Members with persistent asthma who were dispensed appropriate medications that they stayed on during the measurement year (2017). The medication types, fill dates, and day supply are listed on the roster.
4. **Prenatal and Postpartum Care (PPC)** – Roster tracks compliance of initial and subsequent prenatal care in the first trimester, on the enrollment start date, or within 42 days of enrollment. Roster tracks compliance of postpartum visits on or between 21 and 56 days after delivery.
