Subject: **REMINDER - Early Start Roster Available on IEHP's Provider Portal**

The Early Start Program is California's response to federal legislation ensuring that early intervention services for infants and toddlers with disabilities and their families are provided in a manner which is coordinated and family-centered. To ensure that Members receiving IRC Early Start benefits are identified for coordination of care, IEHP has launched an Early Start Roster. The roster lists Members who have been identified as eligible for services with the IRC Early Start Program. The roster is available on the Provider Portal for access by IPAs and Providers. The identification of Members with Early Intervention services provides a method to ensure effective care coordination between the Primary Care Physicians and Early Start Specialists.
