Subject: **Termination of the Provider Capital Fund (PCF) Program**

As of September 1, 2017 Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) is no longer accepting new applications under the Provider Capital Fund (PCF) Program. The PCF Program has been successful in expanding operational capacity by supporting the construction of new clinic facilities, the renovation of existing facilities, and the expansion of existing clinics through new leases. However, in reviewing the needs of our Members and Providers, IEHP has decided to close the PCF program and redirect the remaining resources and funding to the Network Expansion Fund (NEF) Program. We will continue to accept applications for the NEF Program to further support the hiring of PCPs, Specialists and Midlevel practitioners in the Inland Empire.
