 Subject: **P4P Changes – Effective July 1, 2017**

**IMPORTANT P4P CHANGES!!!!**

As Inland Empire Health Plan (IEHP) strives to maintain robust incentive programs for our Providers who are focused on quality health outcomes for our Members, we have restructured a portion of the traditional, online Physician P4P incentive programs to align with the Global Quality P4P Program. For fiscal year 2017-2018, IEHP will transition funds from the Physician P4P Programs to support enhancements to the 2017 Global Quality P4P PCP Program **for dates of service beginning July 1, 2017.**

**The Physician P4P program changes are as follows:**

- 1. Retirement of Asthma and Diabetes P4P components** for dates of service beginning **July 1, 2017**. It is important to note that the 2017 Global Quality P4P program includes asthma and diabetes measures, so your treatment and management of eligible Members continues to count towards P4P incentives.

Diabetes and Asthma services rendered prior to July 1<sup>st</sup> must be submitted online within 2 months of the date of service. Please note that the P4P entry link for these services will be removed effective **September 1, 2017**.

- 2. P4P funding changes for the following P4P components:**

P4P Components	Payment Reduction
Yellow Card	Payment Reduced: <b>from \$150 to \$100</b>
Well Child Visits	Payment Reduced: <b>0-7 years old visits from \$40 to \$25</b> Payment Reduced: <b>11-19 years old visits from \$50 to \$35</b>
Perinatal Services	Payment Reduced: <b>1st Trimester from \$225 to \$200;</b> Payment Reduced: <b>2nd &amp; 3rd Trimester from \$100 to \$75</b>
