Guidelines

Flu shot will be provided to:

Adults

- Recommended for pregnant women and individuals with chronic health conditions

Children

- Three years and older
- Children ages three to eight years old may require two doses of flu vaccine (four weeks apart) based on prior vaccination history
- A parent or guardian must accompany children under 18 years old

Vacuna Contra la Gripe

No se requiere hacer una cita para recibir su vacuna. Se le va hacer una breve evaluación de salud y se le tomara su temperatura.

Guía de Vacunación para Adultos y Niños

Adultos

- Es recomendado para mujeres embarazadas y personas con enfermedades crónicas

Niños:

- 3 años o más
- Niños de 3 a 8 años requieren una segunda dosis 4 semanas después de recibir la primera dosis
- Un padre o guardián debe acompañar a niños menores de 18 años

Prueba de COVID-19

Para hacerse la prueba de COVID-19 se requiere hacer una cita. Se aceptaran visitas sin cita previa hasta agotar pruebas.
