Subject: Complex Case Management (CCM) Program – Severe Chronic Conditions

Do you care for IEHP Members with severe chronic conditions? IEHP is here to help with the **Complex Case Management (CCM) Program for Direct and Delegated Medi-Cal Members.**

What is CCM?	CCM is a program that addresses whole person care by addressing the needs of Members with medical, behavioral, and social determinants of health (SDOH). CCM supports Members, caregivers, and families in coordinating care and services.
What conditions are managed in the CCM program?	 Chronic homelessness, impairing the ability to function in the community. Serious illnesses impacting Members' activities of daily living including: Advanced liver disease Cancer Decompensating neurological conditions New cerebral vascular accident Trauma (current) Chronic physical condition and/or behavioral health symptoms
How are Members referred to the CCM program?	 Medical Management program referrals via IEHP Discharge planner referrals Member, Caregiver, or Provider referral
