Subject:	NEW! Medi-Cal Expansion Initiative effective January 1, 2024 – Adults
	Aged 26 through 49

Beginning January 1, 2024, immigrants of all ages, regardless of immigration status, qualify for Medi-Cal under Senate Bill (SB) 184. Individuals aged 26 through 49 with an Unsatisfactory Immigration Status (UIS) are now included in the expansion of Medi-Cal eligibility and assignment to IEHP and other health plans.

Background

The Adult Expansion for ages 26 through 49 mirrors the Young Adult Expansion (which granted full-scope Medi-Cal to individuals ages 19 through 25), and the Older Adult Expansion (which extended coverage to those aged 50 years and older.) This expansion follows a historic nine-year journey since then-Gov. Jerry Brown signed SB 184 into law in 2015. Full-scope Medi-Cal provides access to essential healthcare services, including primary and preventive care, specialists, pharmaceuticals, and more.

How does this affect your practice?

On or after January 1, 2024, PCPs will see these new IEHP Medi-Cal Members assigned through our standard assignment processes. We are anticipating more than 40,000 new Members to join under this expansion effective February 1, 2024!
