Subject: **Complex Case Management (CCM) Program – Severe Chronic Conditions**

Do you care for IEHP Members with severe chronic conditions? If so, we can help with the **Complex Case Management (CCM) Program** for Direct and Delegated Medi-Cal Members.

What is CCM?	CCM is a program that addresses whole person care by addressing the needs of Members with medical, behavioral, and social determinants of health (SDOH) . CCM supports Members, caregivers, and families in coordinating care and services
What conditions are managed in the CCM program?	Chronic homelessness, impairing the ability to function in the community. Serious illnesses impacting Members’ activities of daily living including: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Advanced liver disease - Cancer - Decompensating neurological conditions - New cerebral vascular accident - Trauma (current) - Chronic physical condition and/or behavioral health symptoms
How are Members referred to the CCM program?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medical Management program referrals via IEHP • Discharge planner referrals • Member, Caregiver, or Provider referral

<p>The Interdisciplinary Care Team (ICT) will create an individualized plan of care for the Member.
